| 7:30 – 9:00 am | Breakfast
We provide a light breakfast and then usher participants to the main auditorium to register. We urge all schools to arrive as early as possible. |
| 8:30 – 9:30 am | Registration and Morning Entertainment
Faculty advisors will register their schools as they enter the Fine Arts Building. An emcee and various student groups from around the state keep participants entertained as we get closer to starting the day. |
| 7:30 – 9:00 am | Diversity Fair
For the third year in a row, we have invited colleges, universities, non-profit organizations and community partners to send representatives to speak with high school students about their commitment to diversity. Interested students and faculty advisors are free to browse the tables after going through breakfast and registration. |
| 9:30 – 10:20 am | Opening Ceremonies
Each year our Executive Committee selects a notable keynote speaker with an inspiring message related to diversity. |
| 10:30 am – 12:00 pm | Discussion Groups & Lunch
Students join a discussion group to talk about diversity issues with students from across the state. Past topics included cliques, peer pressure, and harassment. Meanwhile, faculty advisors gather to have their own discussion on diversity issues and teaching techniques. |
| 12:10 – 1:20 pm | Workshop A
Both students and faculty advisors attend a workshop of their choice. Workshops focus on a variety of themes, including gender, class and poverty, race and ethnicity, sexual orientation, mental and physical challenges, history, and conflict resolution. |
| 1:30 – 2:40 pm | Workshop B
Everyone attends a second workshop of their choice. |
| 2:50 – 3:20 pm | School Meetings
All attendees meet back with their schools or organizations for a discussion on how to take what they've learned back to their local community, and make a positive difference. |
